

## PREPARATION FOR LANDING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Face the direction of travel and hold on to the burner support or the yellow handles on the inside of the basket.
- 2) Pay attention to the landing. Personal belongings will be stowed.
- 3) Bend your knees slightly to absorb any impact.
- 4) Be prepared to bounce or drag for several feet.
- 5) The flight is not over until the balloon is deflated. Stay prepared for landing until instructed to exit the basket by the pilot.
- 6) You will be advised of high wind landings. High wind landings will result in the basket laying over on its side and dragging until stopped. It is imperative to keep arms and legs inside the basket during the landing.
- 7) Do not exit the basket until given permission by the pilot.
